

Abilities and Developmental Levels

1 Develop effective communications skill

- Level 1 — Identify own strengths and weaknesses as initiator and responder in communication situations of the following types, including a variety of audiences: reading, writing, listening, speaking, graphing and reading graphs
- Level 2 — Analyze written and oral communication situations
- Level 3 — Communicate with clarity of message-exchange in communication situations of the following types, including a variety of audiences: reading, writing, listening, speaking, graphing and reading graphs
- Level 4 — Demonstrate sufficient understanding of basic concepts of at least 3 major areas of knowledge to communicate in terms of them
- Level 5 — Demonstrate understanding of communication as historical process involving development of meaning and form in relation to technological and cultural forces
- Level 6 — Communicate effectively through coordinated use of 3 different media that represent contemporary technological advancement in the communications field
